Timing of Match: Senior male 3 Minutes

Senior female, Cadets, Junior, Under 21 Master A-B-C-D 2 Minutes

Explanation of Kumite Master Categories:

Master A/B from 36 to 45 years old Master C/D from 46 to 60 years old

RULES INDIVIDUAL KUMITE

RULES ESHRKF (European Shito Ryu Karate Federation), with some changes.

Referee Panel: 1 Referee (SHUSHIN) - 2/3 Judges (FUKUSHIN)

Atoshi Baraku: 15" from the end of time

Points:

IPPON 1 Points (Chudan and Jodan Tsuki / Uchi)

NIHON 2 Points (Chudan Kicks, Unbalancing and delivering a scoring technique.)

SANBON 3 Points (Jodan Kicks, Throwing or sweeping technique and scoring on a fallen opponent who

is out of feet and lie on matt upper trunk should be on floor).

If upper trunk not lie on a matt for such technique will be awarded Nihon.

Technical Criteria: In any bout, if after full time the scores are equal, but one contestant has obtained "first unopposed score advantage" (SENSHU), that contestant will be declared the winner. In any individual bout, where no score has been obtained by either competitor, or the score is equal without any competitor has obtained 'first unopposed score "advantage", the decision will be made by a final vote of the Referee Panel.A decision in favour of one or the other competitor is obligatory and is taken on the basis of the following criteria:

- a) The attitude, fighting spirit, and strength demonstrated by the contestants;
- b) The superiority of tactics and techniques displayed;
- c) Which of the contestants has initiated the majority of the actions.

Majorities (1 Referees and 2 Judges):

If 2 Judges signal for MIENAI, the Referee can give the point.

In the Promotional Categories, if 1 Judge signal for AKA, 1 Judge for MIENAI and Referee for AO, will be given point to both.

Majorities (1 Referees and 3 Judges)

The majority is determined by 2 flags.

If there are two opinions in favor of AKA and two in favor of AO, will be awarded both.

If the Referee and one Judge show a point for AKA or AO and the other two Judges show TORIMASEN, the Referee's opinion prevails, the same rule will apply to Hantei (Casting Vote).

Prohibited Behaviour: There are two categories of prohibited behaviour, Category 1 and Category 2.

CATEGORY 1: Techniques which make excessive contact, having regard to the scoring area attacked, and techniques which make contact with the throat - Attacks to the arms or legs, groin, joints, or instep - Attacks to the face with open hand techniques - Dangerous or forbidden throwing techniques.

CATEGORY 2: * Feigning, or **exaggerating injury** – Jogai – Mubobi – Avoiding combat – Clinching, wrestling, pushing, or seizing, without attempting a throw or other technique – Techniques, which by their nature, cannot be controlled for the safety of the opponent and dangerous and uncontrolled attacks – ** **Passivity** not attempting to engage in combat – Grabbing the opponents arm or karategi with one hand without immediately attempting a scoring technique or takedown – Attacks with the head, knees, or elbows - Talking to, or goading the opponent, failing to obey the orders of the referee, discourteous behaviour towards the refereeing officials, or other breaches of etiquette – Grapping the opponent with both hands for any other reasons than executing a takedown upon catching the opponents kicking leg.

- * exaggerating will be penalized with HANSOKU CHUI;
- ** Cannot be given after less than the last 15 seconds of the match.

FACE CONTACT - SENIORS: Is allowed SKIN TOUCH.

FACE CONTACT - ESORDIENTI/CADETS/JUNIORES/U21: It is not allowed any kind of contact with the technical arms (Tsuki / Uchi). Is permitted light touch with leg techniques (Geri). Any contact to the Jodan area with arms, however slight, in principle may be penalized.

FACE CONTACT - BAMBINI/RAGAZZI/SPERANZE: It is not allowed any kind of contact. Any contact to the Jodan area, however slight, in principle will be penalized. For this reason, valid techniques that reach a reasonable distance (up to 10 cm) will be considered valid.

RULES OF 10 SECONDS: Any competitor who falls, is thrown, or knocked down, and does not fully regain his or her feet within ten seconds, is considered unfit to continue fighting and will be automatically withdrawn from all Kumite events in that tournament. In the event that a competitor falls, is thrown, or knocked down and does not regain his or her feet immediately, the referee will signal to the timekeeper to start the ten second count-down by a blast on his whistle, at the same time calling the doctor if required. The timekeeper will stop the clock when the referee raises his arm. In all cases when 10 second rules has been started the doctor will examine the contestant, doctor may examine the contestant on the mat.

INDIVIDUAL KATA RULES

PROMOTIONAL CATEGORY ALL BELTS AND OTHER CATEGORY FROM CADETS TO MASTER UNTIL BLUE BELT: COMPETITION WITH SCORE

Competition is divided **by Style**, if the Competitors were less than four, the organization may to form Rengokai Category.

Kata Competition is divided for belts: **WHITE – YELLOW/ORANGE – GREEN/BLUE – BROWN/BLACK** The Competitor with half/belt: White/Yellow, Orange/Green or Brown/Black, they can choose the most appropriate category where to compete.

Exceptionally, the category **All Styles** has been inserted, this is reserved only from Cadets to Master, Brown and Black belts.

Change of Category: Is Permitted only for Classes: ESORDIENTI, CADETS, JUNIORS and UNDER 21, as illustrated below:

- Esordienti may also compete with the Cadets;
- Cadets may also compete with the Juniors;
- Juniors may also compete with the Under 21;
- Under 21 may also compete with Senior.

Kata: The choice of Kata is free, but at each round must perform a different Kata. Athletes from White to Orange Belt, can perform the same kata in each round.

Only for CADETS, JUNIORS, UNDER 21, SENIORS Brow and Black Belt:

Elimination: Competition with Score - Semifinal and Final: with flags, draw 1/3 - 2/4

EXPLANATION: Eliminatory: 3 Rounds with17 and over Competitors – 2 Rounds from 9 to 16 Competitors – 1 Round from 5 to 8 Competitors

The final Round score, selects four Competitors entering the Semifinal.

The Competitor with the highest score will be matched to Competitor with the third highest score, while the Competitor with the second highest score will be matched to Competitor with the fourth highest score.

TEAM KATA RULES

The Team Kata is INTERSTYLE (All Style);

In the Finals there isn't BUNKAI:

Division by belts: until Green belts and Blue/Black belts.

TEAM KATA "DUO" RULES

The Team Kata is INTERSTYLE (All Style), reserved for Classes until **CADETS**; **Division by belts**: until Green belts and Blue/Black belts.

GENERAL RULES

- 1.
